THE ENROLLMENT PROCESS

Step 1: Create Student Profile

Once your information is received, you will be able to utilize this online portal to submit required documents to complete the enrollment process. Step 2: Parent/Guardian Tour

We invite you to explore our classrooms by taking a school tour. Individual tours are available on weekdays by appointment.

Step 3: Submit Your Enrollment Form

First Impressions Learning Academy evaluates each child's school readiness and class placement on an individual basis. Although we consider parental/guardian input, professional assessment, and the child's specific needs, the final decision of an offer of admission and specific grade and class placement rests solely with the school administration.

Step 4: Arrange a Student Visit

- Infants and Toddler students visit for 30 minutes in the classroom with their parents.
- Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten students visit the classroom in the morning for 1 and ½ hours.
- Parents/Guardians may meet with our Director to ask questions and learn more about First Impressions Learning Academy.
